

Music

The children will continue their exploration and learning of 'pulse', 'rhythm' and 'pitch' whilst learning six different styles of music; Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk. Each week you will listen and learn a different style of **In The Groove** song.

Geography

The topic this term is Wonderful World. They will learn about the locations of continents, oceans and countries in relation to the United Kingdom. They will have an understanding about the spherical nature of the Earth. They will continue to build on their map skills developed last term. We will explore the different continents when we visit the World Museum in Liverpool.

Art and Design

The children are exploring 3D art. They will be looking at the work of Andy Goldsworthy and Richard Long. They are creating 3D art outdoors and also using clay to make impressions and plaster casts.

Science

The children will learn what the word weather means and find out how different types of weather can be measured. Children will use a class weather station to observe, measure and record the weather across the seasons. They will also observe changes across the seasons by exploring the signs of autumn and winter through nature and wildlife.



English

This term we are looking at stories from other cultures around the world. These include the Anansi Stories from Ghana West Africa, two stories by Paul Geraghty – The Hunter (Kenya) and The Great Green Forest (South America), Jamil's Clever Cat (Bengal) and How The Animals Got their Tails (Aboriginal Australia). Within these we will look a story mapping and alternative endings, punctuation and using adverbs.

PSCHE

This term we will be looking at the recipe we could use to make and become a good friend. We will relate this to our Bucket filling topic.

Religious Education

The children will be exploring Church, the special place where Christians go to worship. They will connect features of the Church to stories in the Bible.

Physical Education

The children will have two PE sessions this term. Mondays with Mr. Singleton who will be doing multi-sport skills. Wednesdays with Mrs. Speight who is doing hockey skills with Yr1 and Yr2. It is advised that children had shin pads and mouth guards. Mrs Speight is a qualified teacher and also a British Hockey Board level 2 coach so is extremely highly qualified to teach this sport.

Mathematics

The children are continuing to use the Inspire Maths scheme. The Year 2 children will be multiplying by 2,3,4,5 and 10. They will also look at different types of measurement. The Year 1 will be looking at using tens and ones to add and subtract numbers to 20.
