Payments can be made in instalments of £50.00 or multiples of £50. For example, if you wish to pay £150.00, simply select quantity 3 when you add the product to your basket.

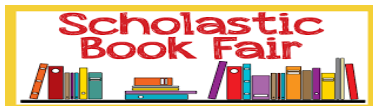
